

Total Square Footage: 6,350 Sq. Ft.

Upper Level: 3175 Sq. Ft.

- "Crew Quarters" (sleeping area) (1,662 Sq. Ft.)
- Sleeps 16 youth in two rooms on bunk beds
- Sleeps 4 adults in two rooms on twin beds
- Each sleeping room has full bath with handicap accessible showers
- Heated and air conditioned (ceiling fans in each room)
- Sprinkler Fire Protection System
- Can be locked off from the Skipper's Deck


- 1550 Sq. Ft. boat storage area (not heated)

RESERVATION INFORMATION

Reservation Deposit ~ Please specify which rooms are needed and immediately notify us of any changes. A \$100 deposit is required to reserve your date(s). Send that in as soon as possible, so we can put you on the calendar. THERE IS NO RESERVATION WITHOUT A DEPOSIT. If two groups are interested in the same date, whichever deposit is received first has the reservation.

Certificate of Insurance ~ Non-Scout groups using the facilities must provide a Certificate of Insurance for \$2 million dollars combined single limit, naming the Boy Scouts of America and the Abraham Lincoln Council as additionally insured for the duration of your group's stay.

A hold harmless agreement must be completed by the organization, as well as a certificate showing non-profit and/or tax exempt status, if appropriate.

Cancellation Policy \sim If an event is canceled due to weather conditions making it unwise to travel to the Center, the reservation deposit will be refunded and there is no further obligation to us.

RULES & INFORMATION

~ Please help us care for our facilities and grounds that we have entrusted to you. Damages other than normal wear and tear are the responsibility of the guest group. Please clean up areas before you leave and report all maintenance issues and/or damages to camp host.

~ Meals are not provided at any facilities. Groups must bring their own tableware. Please keep your food in the "Skipper's Deck" only of the Sailing Training Center. The "Galley" is a warming kitchen with plenty of receptacles for crock pots, warmers, etc. Water should be used conservatively.

~ Please provide adequate adult supervision for all children and youth. Guest groups are fully responsible for supervising their own children during their entire stay on Camp Illinek property.

~ Smoking or use or possession of alcoholic beverages and/or illegal drugs are not permitted on Boy Scout property. Firearms and fireworks are also not allowed.

~ Pets are not allowed.

~ Displays on walls should be hung with "teacher's putty". Please do not use tape on our walls.

~ The group is responsible for any and all damages to camp property and agrees to pay for any such damages.

~ While Scouting makes every effort to accommodate all persons with disabilities, it is a charitable, private organization not subject to the ADA, and any group who uses the property is responsible for ADA compliance and any accommodations necessary for its participants and visitors.

WHAT TO BRING

Individuals will need a sleeping bag or other bedding for a twin or bunk bed, pillow, towels and washcloths, and toiletries. Group may bring their own snacks (limited refrigeration available) and soft drinks.
